CCU Rescinds Precautionary Boil Water Notice to Portion of Port Charlotte Service Area
Edgewater Drive Phase 2 Improvements**

PORT CHARLOTTE, Fla. (Nov. 13, 2015) – Charlotte County Utilities has rescinded the precautionary boil water notice to 434 residences off Harbor Boulevard, south of Edgewater Drive. The Utility will use a combination of phone calls, door hangers and a digital road sign to notify residents that the water is safe for human consumption and cooking.

Affected residences include

- 4194 through 4500 Harbor Blvd.
- 21221 through 21399 Edgewater Dr.
- All residences on Leland Street, Peckham Street, Colonial Street, Sinclair Street, Graham Street, Creek Drive, Seville Place and Colleen Street.
